A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT SEWER RATES

Councilmember Gault offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Flushing City Ordinance 52.106 states:

Sec. 52.106. Establishment of rates.

The rates for total sewer service charges are to be established by resolution of the City Council, which may be enacted apart from the published ordinances as necessary to ensure sufficiency of revenues in meeting operation, maintenance and replacement costs, as well as debt service. Such charges and rates shall be made against each lot, parcel of land or premises which may have any sewer connections with the sewer system of the city, or which may otherwise discharge sewage or industrial waste, either directly or indirectly, into such system or any part thereof. Such charges shall be based upon the quantity of water used thereon or therein, or as estimated by the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, in order to ensure sufficiency of revenues in meeting operation, maintenance and replacement costs, as well as debt service, the following rates have been established:
