## RESOLUTION 2018-11-13 A

### A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE CORRECTIVE ACTION FOR THE CITY OF FLUSHING RETIREMENT HEALTHCARE PLAN

Bade offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, the state of Michigan approved Public Act 202 of 2017 - Protecting Local Government Retirement and Benefits Act; and

**WHEREAS**, local units' retiree health benefit systems are considered underfunded when the retirement health system is less than 40% funded according to the most recent audited financial statements and if the annual required contribution for all of the retirement health system is greater than 12% of the local unit of government's annual governmental fund revenues based on the most recent fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Flushing Retiree Health Care Plan was determined to be underfunded by the Michigan Department of Treasury; and


**WHEREAS**, Public Act 202 of 2017 requires underfunded local units of governments to develop and submit for approval a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to the Municipal Stability Board within 180 days from the date of notification by the Michigan Department of Treasury; and


**WHEREAS**, Public Act 202 of 2017 states Corrective Action Plans must be approved by the local government's administrative officer (city manager) and its governing board (city council); and

**WHEREAS**, the submitted plan must demonstrate through supporting documentation how and when the local unit will reach the 40% funded ratio or how and when the annual required contribution for all of the retirement healthcare systems will be less than 12% of annual governmental fund revenues as defined by Public Act 202 of 2017.


